## Gift Card Wish List

Gift Cards are our number one need, as they allow us to support survivor needs throughout the entire year, and empower survivors to purchase the items they need.

- **Meijer, Walmart, Kroger, Aldi**
  - Assist in providing food items for survivors in our counseling programs
  - Helps provide food for survivors in our shelter program who are residing in the hotel due to limited shelter space or because they do not identify as female
  - Assist in purchasing work clothing including non-slip shoes for the food industry
- **Lowe's, Home Depot**
  - Used to purchase new door locks to increase survivor safety
  - Used to purchase doors/windows that may have been broken by the abuser
  - Used to purchase paint and other home improvement materials to fix damage caused by the abuser
- **Prepaid Visa, Mastercard**
  - These cards assist in fulfilling any needed items outside of a specific store
  - May be used to purchase food/drinks at the airport if fleeing the state
- **Target**
  - Journals for support groups
  - Books for book club
  - Individualized clothing/PJ needs, especially for teen boys and plus-sized clothing
  - Hair care products
  - Supplies to facilitate groups with survivors such as art supplies
  - Birthday decorations for birthday parties at the shelter
  - Purchase blow-up mattresses for emergency situations at our shelter program
- **Sam's Club, Gordon Food Services (GFS), Costco**
  - Snacks for support groups
  - Supplies for our annual parties including summer camp kick-off, Halloween, etc.
  - Food for Shelter/hotel residents
- **Sally's/ Kelly's Beauty Supplies**
  - Purchase culturally specific hair care products
- **Lyft, Uber, Gas Station**
  - Allow survivors access to counseling appointments, job interviews, medical appointments, etc.
  - Allow survivors to have if they have to flee in an emergency
