#### SURVIVOR SERVICES

**24-Hour Hotline** (586-463-6990) - Available 24/7/365 to provide support, safety planning, and resources to survivors of domestic violence, sexual violence, and human trafficking. Hotline staff are also available to support loved ones of survivors, community members, and professionals. Language translation services and teletypewriter (TTY) available. The hotline answers more than 10,000 calls each year.

**Emergency Shelter** (586-463-6990) - A secure, accessible building with 52 beds provides emergency, temporary shelter for survivors and their children who are fleeing from domestic violence or sexual violence. Based on availability, a community partner offers safe boarding to family pets for residents.

**Housing** (586-463-6990) - Rapid Re-Housing and Transitional Housing Programs provide safe, affordable housing and supportive services to survivors

**Human Trafficking** (586-463-6990) - Provides emergency shelter, transitional housing, first response advocacy, and additional services to all survivors of human traffickin-labor or sex-regardless of gender, sexual orientation, or sobriety.

**Forensic Nurse & First Response Advocacy** (586-463-6990) - Available 24/7/365 to provide comprehensive medical forensic exams and emotional support to adults and children who have experienced sexual assault or intimate partner strangulation.

**Advocacy/Counseling** (586-463-4430) - Provides individual and group sessions for adults and children impacted by domestic violence, sexual violence, or human trafficking to promote healing and increase access to resources.

**Personal Protection Order (PPO)** (586-469-7494) - Staff assist the community with Personal Protection Order forms, motions, and e-filing, while providing support, resources, and safety optioning.

**Legal Advocacy** (586-465-9161) - Legal advocates are not attorneys but are well-versed in the legal system and victim's rights. They can provide survivors with advocacy throughout the legal process as well as accompany survivors to court.

**Second Hand Rose** (586-468-3083) - Offers support to survivors via gently used items donated as well as affordable merchandise to the community. All proceeds help provide Services to Turning Point Survivors. Visit our website for store hours and donation schedules.

#### **COMMUNITY EDUCATION & ENGAGEMENT**

**Community Education** (586-868-4547) - Domestic violence, sexual violence, and human trafficking are community issues. Our presentations focus on raising awareness and understanding, ways to support survivors, create healthy relationships, and end violence in our communities. Services are available to organizations, professional audiences, faith-based communities, and other community groups. Visit our website to view our training menu and submit a request.

**Prevention Education** (586-463-4430) - Prevention Education works to educate middle and high school students on consent, healthy relationships, dating violence, and human trafficking through one and two-day classroom presentations. The program also offers education for school staff and parents.

**Survivor Speaker's Bureau** (586-463-4430) - Turning Point's Survivor Speaker's Bureau is an opportunity for survivors or loved ones to share their experiences of abuse and healing with the community.

**Systems Change** (586-463-4430) - Turning Point advocates for community action to end violence and oppression. Our advocacy includes participating in community committees, partnering with survivors to shape public policy, and collaborating with partners in law enforcement, health care, civil and criminal court, and service organizations to improve supports for survivors and increase offender accountability.

**Volunteer** (586-463-4430) - Volunteers are critical to achieving our mission. There are many ways to get involved including direct work with survivors, indirect administrative and fundraising support, and Second Hand Rose. We offer individual and group volunteer experiences, as well as opportunities for community service.


