Second Hand Rose Volunteers

Second Hand Rose is Turning Point's local re-sale shop. Second Hand Rose provides free goods to survivors and affordable new/gently-used items to the community. Donations and shopping dollars from Second Hand Rose help Turning Point fund its programs in the mission to empower survivors of domestic violence, sexual violence, and human trafficking.

Second Hand Rose volunteers help the store run smoothly. Volunteers may:

- Sort donations and decide what is in good condition to sell
- Stock merchandise from the back to the salesfloor
- Make sure merchandise on display looks neat and clean
- Set up displays
- Greet customers and help with their shopping needs

Requirements:

- **1.** Must pass a criminal background check and Central Registry Clearance.
- 2. After interview and background check, must complete 30-minute store orientation
- **3.** Work a minimum of 2 hours per shift.
- 4. Able to work well on your own and on a team.
- **5.** Good at talking to and working with different kinds of people, open and respectful to everyone.
- 6. Communicate accessibility needs as some tasks require lifting or long periods of standing.
- 7. Volunteers under 16 must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian.

Second Hand Rose is also our volunteer opportunity for court-mandated community service. All Turning Point volunteers are subject to a criminal background check prior to placement. A criminal record <u>will not</u> necessarily disqualify an applicant; however, the mission of the organization and the role of the volunteer will be kept in mind when considering the charge. A criminal record is one piece of information used to consider volunteer eligibility in Turning Point programs.
